ALTERNATIVE

Authority Records

LC practice/PCC practice for Alternative: Record a transliterated form of the name in authorized access points for persons, families, and corporate bodies, following the ALA-LC Romanization Tables: Transliteration Schemes for Non-Roman Scripts ☑, approved by the Library of Congress and the American Library Association. Non-Latin forms that appear on the source may be recorded as variant access points in authority records (MARC field 4XX).

Bibliographic Records

LC practice for Alternative: Non-Latin forms that appear on the source may be recorded as parallel fields in bibliographic records (MARC field 880 ☑) for the languages/scripts in the MARC-8 repertoire of UTF-8; see [Policy Statement for 1.4, first alternative](#) LC-PCC PS for the scripts applicable in LC bibliographic records.

PCC practice for Alternative: Follow the PCC Guidelines for Creating Bibliographic Records in Multiple Character Sets ☑ applicable to the PCC program; see [Policy Statement for 1.4, first alternative](#) LC-PCC PS for the scripts applicable in PCC bibliographic records.
